These 3 hors d'oeuvres platters are carved from wild cherry, harvested from a storm-downed tree western Albemarle County, Virginia. They are sealed with a food-safe finish and can be use as shallow bowls, or reversed to use the flat surface for charcuterie serving. #2 and 3 include the dip/toothpick-holder glass. All 3 have the WTJU logo brand on flat bottom surface. - Jim Mandell
